Rules:

1. McLean County 4-H members interested in participating in the McLean County Royalty Contest must be at least 16 years of age as of September 1, 2016.
2. Candidates, if selected to be on court, must agree to participate in the preliminary contest, final competition, and activities each day of the McLean County 4-H Fair.
3. Preliminary contest judging criteria is 100 percent judges’ interview. Royalty contest judging criteria is based on speech and communication skills and stage presence. Prepared speech at the Final Competition is to be no more than 90 seconds in length.
4. Members of the court must attend the McLean County Fair each day and present awards and ribbons, attend the evening programs and fulfill other duties as assigned.
5. Entries are due in the Extension office no later than 4:30 p.m. on June 30, 2017.
6. If a candidate is more than 10 minutes late for this contest, they will be disqualified.
7. Any finalist may be relieved of their duties by the Show Committee and County Director.
8. Contestant Final Information form and signed contract must be completed and returned at the Court Dinner on Wednesday, July 26, 2017.
