

2022 Pickup Truck Pull-off Rules for Stock and Altered Gas and Diesel Wednesday, August 3

## Pickup Truck Classes:

- A. Stock Diesel Class
  - 1. No Turbo modifications
  - 2. Single CP3
  - 3. No hood stacks
  - 4. No hanging weights
  - 5. Weight 8,500
  - 6. Duallys allowed
- B. Work Stock Diesel Trucks
  - 1. Stock appearing turbo, or 366 based turbo
  - 2. Dual CP3's allowed
  - 3. No hood stacks
  - 4. Hanging weights allowed
  - 5. Weight 8,500
  - 6. Duallys allowed if original from factory
- C. Open Class
  - 1. Run what you've got
  - 2. No sanctioned trucks
  - 3. Nitrous allowed
  - 4. Weight 8,500
- D. Gas Class
  - 1. Weight 8,500
  - 2. Must be street legal with plates and insurance
  - 3. Duallys allowed
  - 4. Nitrous allowed

## **General Rules:**

- 1. <u>All</u> entrants will abide by the rules and decisions of the judges and fair management, and their decisions are FINAL.
- 2. Machines must be in safe mechanical and operating condition; this will be left up to the judge's discretion.
- 3. Sign up, tech, and weigh in will begin at 3 pm, until the start of the event at 6:00 p.m.
- 4. Owners do not have to drive their truck. Owners must present a current insurance card, vehicle registration, and valid driver's license to register. The registration and VIN must match.
- 5. Truck can register in two or more classes.

- 6. Truck inspections, before and after your pull, that find violations to these rules will result in an immediate disqualification of truck and driver; all registration fees and any prize money will be forfeited.
- 7. Fuel additives allowed. Gas trucks are allowed fuel additives and any sort of race fuel. If asked to disclose product you must provide additive name.
- 8. <u>All</u> stock trucks must have stock wheel base.
- 9. Hitch height will be 26 inches and have an opening of 3 <sup>3</sup>/<sub>4</sub>" inches.
- 10. Beds must be empty of loose items. Fuel tanks or tool boxes must be removed.
- 11. Stock Diesel truck engines must be in stock location, in stock motor mounts.
- 12. First truck out in each class can decline the distance and come back 3rd.
- 13. Puller will have 2 chances to get past 75 feet marker.
- 14. All drivers must wear shirt, shoes, and long pants. Team members must wear shirt, shoes, and shorts or long pants.
- 15. All drivers, team members, pit crew, guests and attendees in the pit must sign a RELEASE AND WAIVER OF LIABILITY FORM.
- 16. All money must be paid at time of entry. CASH ONLY.
- 17. Alcohol and drugs are not permitted. Violation of this rule by a driver or any member of a driver's team will result in immediate disqualification of the truck and driver.
- 18. IPA Track Rules will be enforced.
- 19. Pit will be open at 2 pm.
- 20. Each driver will receive 3 armbands to pit area; 1 for driver and 2 for team members. All other team members and guests must pay \$20 per pit pass armband (includes admission in to fair).
- 21. Registration table on event night (August 3) will be open from 3:00pm until 6:00pm.

  - Out of County residents \$30 cash per class.
